Distracted | Part 1

According to Miriam Webster, the most common usage of the word "distracted" means *unable to think about or pay attention to something: unable to concentrate.* Our lesson today was about a man who needed more time. Begin by reading Joshua, Chapters 9 and 10.

God will always give you enough time to do the things He has asked you to do if we inquire of Him. What are the things that distract you from God's will and your relationship with Him?

We may not get a sun standing still in the sky, or five kings and a hailstorm to aid us, but *God multiplies our time when we follow Him.* (Joshua 10:9-14.) What do you do to make sure you are not distracted from God's presence and His purpose for your life?

Where does the time you spend get you in life and in eternity? Where will you get more time?
