God wants His family to be known for its love more than anything else! We are a team of believers. And public worship is not unlike our pep rally. Jesus is alive, and public worship is our opportunity and reminder through preaching, praying, praising and participating. Begin your study by reading Hebrews 10:24-25.

Why do you go to church? In your busy life, where does regular church attendance rank on the priority list? What things come before public worship?

Consider the idea that it is not what you *take* from public worship, but what you *bring* to it that matters. What do you bring? How often do you feel you are there to support or affirm — to *love!* - other believers?

Understanding that public worship is another element of knowing Christ personally, and that someone there might need your affirmation or encouragement, how willing are you to commit to church attendance each week?
